

FOOD TRUCK!




Friendly reminder! The Board is hosting a Food Truck on Wednesday, October 26th, from 4-7PM at the clubhouse.

- The review process technically has up to 30 days for a final determination; most applications do not take this long, but please plan your time frame accordingly.
- Our apologies, but we cannot expedite the improvement application process, as each application deserves to be thoroughly reviewed to ensure projects meet community standards—and to safeguard your purchase(s).
- The more details you can provide giving a clear idea of your completed project, the quicker the review process will be.
- Please keep in mind all rules and regulations—including the improvement application process—is something all Members agree to adhere to, by choosing to live in Deer Run. Thanks!
