Markers must be located next to the lamp post and driveway, and they must be visible and not blocked by anything—including holiday decorations.


PLEASE REMEMBER, SNOW PLOWING OCCURS WITH 2" OR MORE OF STANDING SNOWFALL.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS!!

If you are heading South to enjoy milder temperature this winter, please make sure you winterize your house!

A few helpful tips to keep in mind are:

- Forward your mail, and ask someone you trust to regularly check on your home, and provide them with a spare key in case of emergencies.
- Turn on your alarm systems and motionactivated lights; set interior lights on timers.
- If you are not heating your home while away, turn off your water supply and drain the pipes completely; add non-toxic antifreeze rates for plumbing systems, to toilet tanks and bowls.
- If you keep the heat on in your home, turn off the water supply, once you verify with your boiler servicing professional it is safe to do so; shut off water to dish and clothes washers, and maintain heat in your home.
- Set the temperature to a minimum of 55 degrees Fahrenheit, and leave the furnace running to prevent pipes from freezing.
