PARKING REMINDERS:

- Please remember there is no overnight parking on the street—for additional parking, please park at the Clubhouse. This is for all visitors, including caregivers.
- * During a snow emergency, please remove all vehicles form the street, day and night, to ensure the snow removal services can be provided efficiently and effectively.
- If your vehicle is parked in your driveway during heavy snowfall, snow removal services will not clear around your vehicle, nor will they come back on-site once services are complete.
- * The storage of boats, canoes, campers, recreational vehicles, trucks, trailers, pickup trucks, or inoperable vehicles of any kind are prohibited in any Common Elements area.
- * A recreational vehicle, camper, or boat may be parked at the Unit to accommodate loading and/or unloading for no more than 8 hours—so long as traffic flow is not interfered with during this time.
- * With prior notification, exceptions may be made to store recreational vehicles at the clubhouse parking area for one night only; occupant vehicles that cannot be parked in the garage or driveway should be parked at the clubhouse or tennis parking areas on a temporary basis, not to exceed 72 hours.


FINANCIALS: As of December 2022, our Total Operating Funds were at \$37,586.92 and Total Reserves Funds were at \$1,197,679.41.

- Please keep in mind, submitting a request does not mean your issue will be addressed—but it will be evaluated and considered by an Arborist, and then the Board will proceed based on the recommendations of the professional, as well as the best interests of the community, providing on what the budget allows.
- Please also keep in mind, typically only dying and/or dead trees are removed—and once removed, they are not replaced.
- If you would like to remove and/or plant a replacement tree yourself, you will need to follow the Improvement Application process, and then allot time for a response before proceeding and/or discarding your project.
