ATTENTION RESIDENTS!

IMPORTANT WASTE MANAGEMENT UPDATES ARE TAKING PLACE IN THE NEAR FUTURE!

PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU ARE PREPARED!

- Inflation rates are hitting everyone hard, and our trash services are unfortunately no exception; WM has increased their fees from a little over \$32,000 in 2021-2022 to just over \$64,000 in 2023.
- The cost for our community pick-up for a year is approximately \$39,000 for trash and approximately \$25,000 for recycling.
- In order to keep costs down, the Board has carefully reviewed all options and made the decision to proceed with one (1) trash receptacle per home.
- The recyclable collection will be replaced by utilizing a large 8YD recyclable bin located at the end of the Deer Run cul-de-sac; it will be emptied once a week.
- The noted changes above will save the Association almost \$25,000/year!
- If you would like to continue recyclable services on your own, please reach out to WM to make arrangements with them directly for individual recyclable billing. Please go to wm.com if you are interested in signing up for this service.
- John Bertsche has graciously agreed to be our main point-of-contact, as some residents may need to change out the trash bins currently in use. He can be reached at 937.477.2629. Please keep in mind John is a volunteer, and is working hard for the Association, so please make sure to call during appropriate hours and kindly allot a reasonable time frame for responses.
